# **RE: Transition Year Trip to Barcelona/Salou**

The transition year end of year trip will be to Barcelona and Salou this year. This trip will last for four days from Tuesday 14th to Friday 17th May, 2024. This trip will allow us to complete the event planning requirements for the Gaisce programme. The following is a sample itinerary which is subject to change:

#### **BARCELONA/SALOU - MAY 2024**

# Day 1: Arrival & Day in Barcelona

Assemble at the school and transfer to the airport for your flight to Barcelona. On arrival, transfer to Barcelona for a guided tour of the city. Some of the sights you can see along your tour, time permitting, could include: La Sagrada Familia Exterior; a monumental church dedicated to the Holy Family and Gaudi's most famous work, The Gothic Quarter and Cathedral; the oldest part of Barcelona, home to a maze of old narrow cobbled streets with a fantastic atmosphere. There are scenic old squares and a museum to be found along the way, Passeig de Gràcia; Barcelona's most magnificent and elegant avenue contains several of the city's most celebrated pieces of architecture. On your way to Salou, stop off in Tarragona for some free time. A city full of surprises with thousands of years of civilization just waiting to be discovered. Spend time at the beach in Salou before an evening meal at your accommodation.

#### Day 2: Full Day in Barcelona

Your group can visit Barcelona's largest football stadium, **Nou Camp**, home to Barcelona FC. You can be taken around the renowned stadium, allowing you to sense and re-live the history of the club. Alternatively, you can tour **Estadi Cornellà-El Prat**, home of RCD Espanyol. Explore the centre of Barcelona and enjoy a walk down **La Rambla**, the well known shopping and tourist promenade. Following all of this, you may go to the shopping centre, Parc Central, which is full of shops, restaurants and fast-food places. You can also visit the famous **Picassso Museum**. Meet your coach and transfer to your accommodation for an evening meal. After the meal you can visit the centre of Salou for an evening walk.

# Day 3: Full Day in Port Aventura

Today you will enjoy a fun filled day at **Port Aventura**. Here you will be spoilt for choice with exhilarating rides, magical parades and exciting shows on offer. Return to your accommodation where you can have an evening meal before enjoying a game of bowling at a nearby bowling alley.

# Day 4: Day in Barcelona & Departure

This morning you may transfer to **Montserrat**, a spectacularly beautiful Benedictine monk mountain retreat about one-hour North West from Barcelona. Not only is Montserrat Monastery of significant religious importance but the natural beauty surrounding the monastery is simply breathtaking. You will have the chance to travel to the top of the mountain in the **Funicular de San Juan** cable cars. Another highlight of your visit to Montserrat Monastery is to listen to the famous Basilica choir boy performances of Gregorian chants and other genres of religious choral music. The performances can be heard free of charge in the Basilica at 13:00 daily. The Basilica is also home to the Reverend La Moreneta. Return to Barcelona to visit the **Cosmo Caixa Science Museum**. Depart by coach to the airport for your return flight home.
