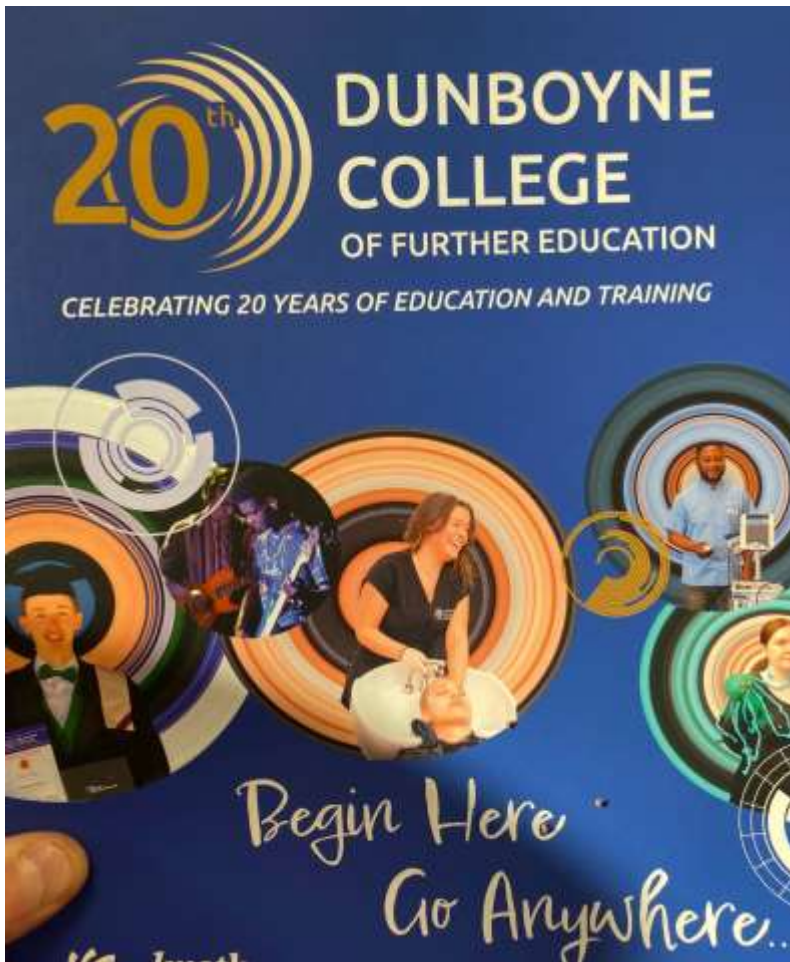


Exploring Engineering Excellence: Tara Engineering Students' Insightful Day at Combilifts Headquarters
