## Class Slane attend Cinema in Blanchardstown

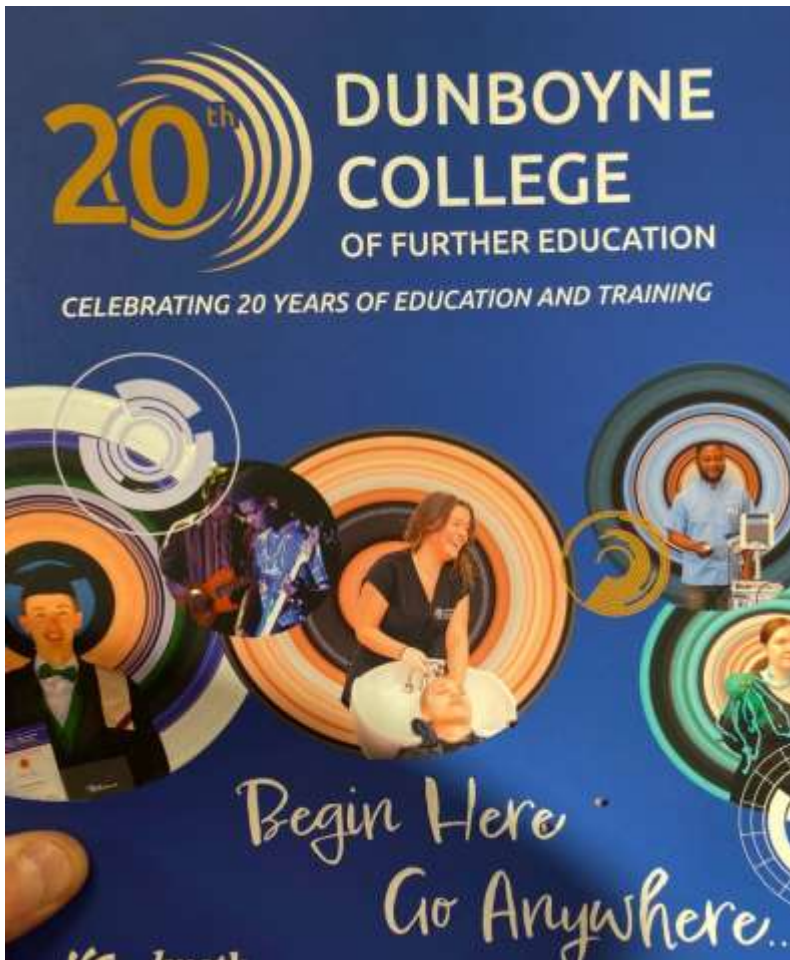
Class Slane and a selection of JCSP students enjoyed a fantastic day at ODEON Isense cinema in Blanchardstown.
